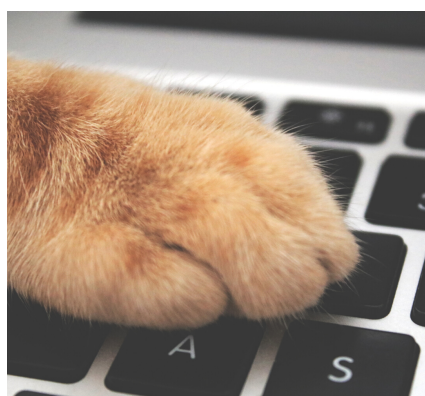




Wirral Whiskers Mewsletter
